REOPENING PROTOCOLS



ALL GUIDELINES WILL GO INTO EFFECT UPON REOPENING UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE, JUNE 2020. AS GOVERNMENT GUIDELINES EVOLVE OUR PROTOCOLS WILL ADJUST ACCORDINGLY.

PICK UP & DROP OFF

- ♦ Please drop off & pick up your dancer in front of our main entrance
- Please park in a parking spot to avoid congestion at our entrance
- ♦ Parents & Guardians please remain in your vehicle
- ♦ For our younger dancers (3-7 yrs old), you may drop them off at the door but parents will not enter the building

HEALTH SURVEY - Please conduct this survey with your dancer prior to attending class

According to the CDC "People with COVID-19 have had a wide range of symptoms reported – ranging from mild symptoms to severe illness. Symptoms may appear 2-14 days after exposure to the virus. People with these symptoms may have COVID-19:

- Fever or chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea

- Anyone with the above symptoms will be sent home immediately
- If your dancer has an underlying health condition, they should not attend an in-person practice
- If any attendee or staff member has a positive COVID-19 test result, we will immediately advise all participants and follow all guidelines provided by the CDC and the Commonwealth of MA

CHECK IN PROCESS

- ♦ Dancers will apply hand sanitizer prior to entry
 - o Each dancer must have their own sanitizer with their name on it
 - o We will have sanitizer available, however, there is limited supply
- A Kadee's Tumbleweed staff member will take attendance and log your dancer's temperature using a non-touch infrared thermometer upon entry
- ♦ Masks must be worn when entering and waiting
- Dancers must arrive in their dancewear
- ♦ Dance bags will not be allowed in the dance studio, all bags must be kept in the hallway in designated area
- ♦ Any water bottles must be labeled with your dancer's name

SOCIAL DISTANCING

- ◆ The number of people allowed, including staff, is limited to current government guidelines
- Class times are adjusted to allow for cleaning and maintaining guidelines
- Dancers spacing during class will be marked on the floor
- ♦ Waiting & spectator areas are closed congregating will not be allowed inside or outside of the facilities
- ♦ Any dancer who is unable to abide by these policies will be unable to attend class in person they will have the option to attend class via ZOOM

INSTRUCTORS

- Instructors will ensure they maintain the appropriate distance from students and staff
- Instructors will keep contact with dancers and tumblers to an extreme minimum & sanitize throughout class
- ♦ Instructors will wear face masks
- ♦ No lifts or partner work will take place
- ♦ We will limit use of equipment during class, anything used and high touch traffic areas will be sanitized
